

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-003

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO DETENTION FEES COLLECTED BY BRAZORIA COUNTY CONSERVATION AND RECLAMATION DISTRICT NO. THREE (“ THE DISTRICT”)

WHEREAS, the District deems it necessary to update the fee schedule for the purchase of credits in their Regional Detention Ponds and;


WHEREAS, the District will review and approve the conveyance to the Detention Pond from each site.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BRAZORIA COUNTY CONSERVATION AND RECLAMATION DISTRICT NO. THREE: will adopt the following fees for credits in Regional Detention Ponds:


1. A fee of \$ 25,000.00 per acre-foot for purchase of Regional Detention.
 - a. Fee for Regional Detention Storage will be required to be paid in full before the drainage plan of proposed development is approved by the District Board.
 - b. Fee for Regional Detention Storage is transferable but non-refundable. If purchased detention storage of a project is not fully utilized, the remaining will be allowed to be kept for future development of that project.
 - c. For development of projects in coastal areas (not inland developments) where regional detention storage is not available, and it is determined that the released unrestricted flows from the development will not have any adverse impact on an existing drainage watershed; impact fees equal to regional detention fees will be allowed to be purchased for future improvements of the drainage watershed.
